BURGLARY

NOVEMBER 2023

1-WATERFALL ROAD N14. On 19NOV23 at 1515 hours. Victim reported that two males have climbed over scaffoldings on unoccupied building site and stolen tools. CCTV shows suspects actions. Further investigations shows that the two suspects were previous builders collecting tools that were left at location.

2-DAWLISH AVENUE N13. On 26NOV23 at 17:30 hours Police called after the victim was reporting that she was at home with her partner, and they were both in the lounge of the address with the curtains closed. They had heard a noise from the front of the address that at first they thought was the cat, but they were aware that it was not the cat and there were 3 suspects with their faces covered trying to get into the address. They managed to force open the doors and were just inside the address when they were confronted by the victims and the suspects made off.

3-BROONFIELD AVENUE N13. Between Monday 27NOV23 11:00 and Tuesday 28NOV23 10:25, Entry has been gained via the front door of the small one bedroom property, which is a converted garage. The door has been forced open by a tool being into wedged the panel and frame and the centre panel being forced in. The resident is currently in prison. It is unknown if any property has been taken.

4-ARNOS GROVE N14. On Tuesday 28NOV23 at Between 17:30 and 19:15hours. Suspect(s), in the rear garden area of the property, had stacked a garden chair onto a garden table and pulled it up next to the rear single storey kitchen extension that juts out from the rear of the property; it is

suspected the suspect(s) then walked along the roof of the kitchen extension to a first floor window and gained entry through the window as it was slightly ajar, the frame of the window was slightly snapped, and the window glass pane was horizontally cracked. Suspect(s) stolen jewellery.

5-SELBORNE ROAD N14. On Tuesday 28NOV23. At 1950hrs. A vehicle has been broken into. Following this car being broken into a house key has been taken from the car, which has been used to gain entry to the property, where there has been a LOUIS VUITTON Hand bag, left in the front hallway, which has been taken, the victims believe that no other property has been taken.

6-SELBORNE ROAD N14. On Tuesday 28NOV23 at 1800 hours. Entry gained through the rear window leading to Living room / kitchen, alarm has activated and victim believes that nothing was taken.

DECEMBER 2023

1-FORESTDALE ROAD N14. On 02DEC23 between 1400 and 1820 hours. Officers attended and noted the probably entry point as the 1st floor bedroom window, which had been smashed in order to unlock. It is believed that suspects have climbed over the garage and into the garden, then onto the gazebo to get to the first floor window. British currency and jewellery was stolen from property.

2-RAITH AVENUE N14. On Wednesday 06DEC23 between 0700 and 1820 hours. The rear patio door has been smashed and the suspect/s has entered via the hole in the smashed glass. The lounge has been left as an untidy search. Along with the main bedroom upstairs, all the wardrobes have been emptied and again, a chest of drawers. The spare bedroom has also been left as an untidy search, the bed was moved, and the draws in the bed have all been gone through. Two passports have been stolen.

3-ABBOTSHALL AVENUE N14. Between 1200 of Wednesday 06DEC23 and 1955 of Thursday 07DEC23. The upstairs window in one of the bedrooms was open and had clearly been broken into as two cracks were visible next to each lock. This window leads out onto a flat roof over the extension of the kitchen and was what the suspect used to get to this window. Not known is property was stolen.

4-HALTHORN AVENUE N13. On Thursday 05DEC23 at 1200 hours. Suspect entered the property through the broken front window. The property has been searched untidy, but nothing has been stolen as the house is unoccupied at the moment and a small amount of furniture is left on the property.

5-RAITH AVENUE N14. On Saturday 09DEC23 at 1300 hours. Suspect entered the property through a broken front door. An untidy search was conducted in the house. Drawers were partially open and items were scattered across the floor in several rooms. The property has not been occupied for the past 12 months. Nothing was stolen.

6-POWYS LANE N13. At 1955 hours on 19DEC23. The front door was damaged by two males who broke into the property. An untidy search was conducted in the house. The keys to the vehicle were taken from the radiator at the entrance hall and the vehicle was stolen. It is

unknown if other property has been stolen. The vehicle was found by police a few hours later via a tracking system and returned to the owner.

7-CRANFORD AVENUE N13. Sunday 31DEC23 2040 hours. CCTV shows two suspects breaking into the property through the rear bathroom window on the first floor. It had been smashed with both panes broken through, and the handle was forced open. It appears that burglars have climbed onto the fence at the rear of the property and climbed up the slanted rear roof on top of an extension, to access the window. It appears that the alarm system has scared off the intruders and they have fled. Nothing was stolen.

8-CRANFORD AVENUE N13. On Sunday 31DEC23 at 2045 hours. Unknown suspects have entered the property. It is believed that the entrance is made from the rear of the property through the brook. They have used a ladder to get into the small box room on the first floor, one of the windows was smashed but the ladder was on the other window which was left open. It is not known if anything was stolen.

9-SEAFIELD ROAD N11. Between 1500 and 1830 on Sunday 31DEC23. Suspects broken into property via damaging front window. Untidy search was conducted. It is unknown if anything was stolen.

JANUARY 2024

1-SELBORN ROAD N14, On Wednesday 03JAN24 at 1830. Suspect has forced entry via window to gain entry, although disturbed and no property taken.

2- SELBORN ROAD N14, On Thursday 01JAN24 between 1830 and 1900 hours. Suspects unknown have accessed victim's room, forcing the door and stealing items from within, suspects have also damaged the victim's television in the process. On the date shown victim left the room locked and secure at about 0800 hours. However the rear door of the house is often left insecure as it does not close properly and some residents use it as access as they don't have a key to the front.

3- POWYS LANE N13. Between 1500 hours of 22DEC23 and 1400 hours of 07JAN24. Unknown suspects broke into the property via rear first floor window. Untidy search was conducted British currency was stolen.

4- HAWTHORN AVENUE N13. On 07JAN24 between 1400 and 2200 hours. Rear glass patio door had been brooked by unknown suspects to gain entrance to property. It is unknown if any property have been stolen.

5- LULWORTH COURT, CANNON HILL N14. On 27JAN24 at 0100, suspect gain entrance to the property by breaking the glass of window in the living room and forcing it open. When inside the property suspect walk through the living room and has opened victims bedroom door and turned the light on. Victim shouted and suspect left via front door taking victims keys.

Burglary non-residential

NOVEMBER 2023

Diamond Supermarket, CANNON HILL N14. On 14NOV23 at 0224 hours. Two suspects pulled up onto the pavement outside the store at 0218hrs. One suspect gets off the bike whilst the other pulls forward. SUS1 then opens a large bag and pulls out a large industrial angle grinder which has a sling attached to it. SUS2 then gets off the bike and picks up the grinder and begins cutting slats in the metal shutters. They continue doing this for several minutes before they have removed several slats. They then use the grinder on the hinged lock of the door, cutting this. They both then try to pull the sliding door open for some time, but they are unable to pull it open. They then both gotten back onto the bike and headed onto waterfall road.

DECEMBER 2023

CHANDOS AVENUE N14. Between Tuesday 19th December at 1700 hours and Wednesday 20th December at 0800 hours, suspect has forced entry to property and stolen a packet of cigarettes within. Venue is a building site and unoccupied overnight.

THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

NOVEMBER 2023

1-THE GREEN N14, From 23OCT23 to 30OCT23. BLUE HONDA JAZZ YD59UJM. Vehicle was involved in RTC, vehicle was left at a road side. Vehicle stolen by unknown suspect.

2-BOWES ROAD N11, Saturday 18NOV23 2305 hours. Black Toyota Hilux. Vehicle was found by police in Harold Wood RM3 on 24NOV23 displaying false number plates. Vehicle recovered by owner.

3-CORRI AVENUE N14, between 1500 hours of 28NOV23 and 1300 of 29NOV23, Blue NISSAN Navara, SL68MTY. Vehicle stolen from location.

1-CRANFORD AVENUE N13. Between 2200 of 09JAN24 and 0730 of 10JAN24. A Grey Audi was stole from location. Vehicle was found by police on Linwood Crescent EN1, on 11JAN23 and returned it to owner.

2-BRYCEDALE CRESCENT N14. Between Thursday 18JAN24 1800 and Friday 19JAN24 0900 hours. A Black Mercedes S350 VRM- KT67DTF. Unknown suspects used an unknown method to steal the vehicle from a location. The vehicle is keyless victim still holds vehicle's keys.

3- SEAFIELD ROAD N11. On Thursday 25JAN24 at 0130. A Blue Ford fiesta VRM LP16YKA, unknown suspect stolen vehicle from location.

4- St Monica's RC Primary School, CANNON ROAD N14. Between Friday 26JAN24 at 1730 and Saturday 27JAN24 at 1400. A blue Volkswagen Sharan VRM WA51UNR. Vehicle stolen from location by unknown suspect. Victim finished work and went to the car, the car had a mechanical issue and he could not get the vehicle to start so the victim left it where it was parked and would go back the next morning to check. The victim went to CANNON ROAD on 27JAN24 approximately at 1030 hours with a mechanic to check what was wrong with the vehicle. When he arrived at CANNON ROAD N14, the vehicle was not where he left it the night before.

5- BELMONT AVENUE N13. On Sunday 28JAN24 between 1320 and 1420. A Blue KIA Ev6 Gt-Line VRM LY23XWB was stolen from location by unknown suspect.

THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

NOVEMBER 2023

1-Travelodge, THE GREEN N14. Between 1730 hours of 08NOV23 and 0735 hours of 09NOV23. Attempt to break into Van. Suspect (s) peeled back the metal but not managed to open the door.

2-FORESTDALE ROAD N14. On 11NOV23 at 2200 hours. Number plates stolen from vehicle at location.

3-Travelodge, THE GREEN N14, On 15NOV23 1600 hours. Unknown suspect attempted to broken into Van via damaging the side door, vehicle alarm gone off, nothing was stolen.

4-BROOMFIELD AVENUE N13. On 19NOV23 between 2200 and 0800 hours. Vehicle broken into, handbag and disabled badge stolen from it.

DECEMBER 2023

1-ASHRIDGE GARDENS N13. On 01DEC23 at 0445hours. Vehicle forgotten unlocked, one male was shown on ring doorbell broken into the vehicle and stolen a bank card.

2-ASHRIDGE GARDENS N13. On 01DEC23 at 0120 hours. Vehicle broken into, CDs and phone charge have been taken. CCTV shows two white males trying car doors in people's driveways.

3-POWYS LANE N13. On 05DEC23 at 0435 hours. CCTV shows one male opening the car with what appear to be an electronic device. Suspect searched vehicle but there was not valuables in the car nothing was stolen. He then proceed to try to unlock another vehicle in the driveway but not succeed.

4-MORTON WAY N14. On 06DEC23 0500 hours. A Vehicle was broken into. Nothing stolen.

5-ABBOTSHALL AVENUE N14. On 08DEC23 at 0325 hours. A vehicle was attempted to be broken into by two males. At around 0330 hours, the alarm went off. A neighbour saw two

males interfering with a vehicle and shouted at them, they disturbed the males that left the location. Nothing was stolen.

6-WESTMINSTER DRIVE N13. Between 1700 on 21DEC2023 and 1130 of 22DEC23. A Vehicle broken into. A jacket was stolen but then left at the end of the road. Victim recovered the jacket.

7-MINCHENDEN CRESCENT N14. On 22DEC23 at 2340 hours. Van broken into. A Flood light was stolen from vehicle.

JANUARY 2024

1-Travelodge, THE GREEN N14. On 02JAN24 1730 hours. A van was attempted to broken into by one male that was trying to drill a hole on the van's door. The male was disturbed by a van driver and jumped into a vehicle driven by another male.

2-TOWNSEND AVENUE N14. On 03JAN24 between 1300 and 1330 hours. A van was broken into. Tools have been stolen from it.

3-OAKFIELD ROAD N14. Between 1500 of 13JAN24 and 1100 of 14JAN24. A vehicle was broken into and tools were stolen from it.

4-POWYS Lane N13. On Monday 15JAN24 0003 hours. CCTV shows one male with face covered smashing vehicle window, 15.00 British currency was stolen from it.

5-WATERFALL Road, N11. Between 1000 of Tuesday 16JAN24 and 1030 of Wednesday 17JAN24. Disabled blue badge was stolen from vehicle by unknown suspect(s). The vehicle was left unlocked by victim.

6-MINCHEDEN Crescent N14. Between 2100 of Wednesday 17JAN24 and 0900 of Thursday 18JAN24. Disabled blue badge was stolen from vehicle by unknown suspect(s) using unknown method.

7-BELMONT Avenue N13. Between 1800 of Monday 15JAN24 and 1450 of Thursday 18JAN24. Number plates stolen from vehicle by unknown suspects.

8-ASHRIDGE Gardens N13. On Friday 19JAN24 at 0330. CCTV Shows one female opening the vehicle and taken number of items from vehicle, later the items were found down the road, victim recovered most items. 30.00 British currency was stolen.

9- Travelodge, THE MALL N14. From Wednesday 23JAN24 at 1800 to Thursday 24JAN24 at 0800. Van broken into and tools stolen from it.

10- BROOKDALE N11. On Wednesday 24JAN24 at 0500. Vehicle broken into via smashed window. Louis Vitton bag, passport, apple airpods, driving licence were stolen from vehicle.

Arson Vehicle

BOWES ROAD N11. Between 0120 and 0205 hours of 01NOV23. The owner of the vehicle and occupant of the location stated that she had CCTV footage which shows Two males

moving to the front passenger side door of the vehicle with one male breaking the glass window and the other lighting an object in his hand and throwing it into the car which has then ignited causing the interior of the car to catch fire. Both males have then ran away from the address. LFB and police do not know what flammable item was used to set the vehicle alight further whatever container was used has been destroyed in the flames with no trace of what was used. LFB said that the fire had been started and contained inside the vehicle and had no spread from the vehicles interior. Furthermore they had made the vehicle safe via disconnecting the battery.

ARRESTS

DECEMBER 2023

MINCHENDEN CRESCENT N14. On 22nd December 2023, three suspects were arrested after a resident called police to inform them that 3 males were interfering with vehicles on location. Three male suspects were detained by the police. After investigation, it was determined that they were involved in at least one burglary and the theft of a motor vehicle in another Ward. The connection between the suspects and the burglaries in Arnos Grove is still unclear.

POWYS LANE N13. On 04DEC23 at 1415 hours. Officers on patrol noted one vehicle with what look like to be on cloned plates. Officers stopped the vehicle and detained one male who was arrested straight away and then searched under S32 PACE he was initially arrested for driving offences relating to the making off from police, He was also arrested for possession of criminal property as he had approximately £4,000 in cash in his bag which he could not account for at the time.

JANUARY 2024

FOX LANE N13 .On SATURDAY 27JAN24 a marked police vehicle was on patrol when attention was drawn to a Black VOLKSWAGEN Tiguan, travelling on CHINGFORD ROAD E17 towards CROOKED BILLET ROUNDABOUT. This vehicle was a confirmed clone. The vehicle was followed onto the A406 where communications were taken by the police helicopter. The Vehicle eventually came to a stop at FOX LANE N13, the driver and sole occupant entered at a property, prior to police arrival. Entry was gained into the Vehicle, true identity, shown lost/stolen. (Criminal property disguised.) Within the boot of the vehicle was a set of false number plates and a suitcase containing a large amount of empty vacuum pack bags, something police associate with packing cannabis from a cannabis factory.

The property was searched and a large quantity of cannabis was found, in various places, not consistent with personal use. Some of the cannabis was found in vacuum bags that matched those found in the VW outside. Also found were several brown blocks, larger than a bar of soap, believed to be heroin. And a machete, a large amount of cash and what appeared to be some sort of ledger/diary. Suspect was arrested.

DRUGS

NOVEMBER 2023

BOWES ROAD N11. 19NOV23. A cannabis factory was found at location. Between 100 and 200 full-grown plants were seized by police.

THEFT PERSON

NOVEMBER 2023

1-THE GREEN N14. On Wednesday 08NOV23 at 0020 hours. Mobile phone snatched from victim hand by suspect in pedal bike.

2-ACCESS ROAD FROM BOWES ROAD TO ARNOS GROVE STATION, N11. On Wednesday 08NOV23 at 2340 hours. Two males threatened the victim stating they would beat the victim up if the victim did not give them the phone. Victim gave the phone. The suspects run off.

3-Sainsbury Supermarkets, BOWES ROAD, N11. On 11NOV24 at 1140. The cash machine went blank after victim inserted the card into the machine, victim could not retrieve his card, He went to the bank and they informed the victim that money had been withdrawn from his account at the same ATM.

4-Post Office, BOWES ROAD N11. On 16NOV23 at 1200. Victim forgotten small bag at the post office, when victim realised it returned to collect it but nothing was found.

DECEMBER 2023

1-Old Cherry Tree, THE GREEN N14. On 23DEC23 at 0025. Victim left wallet next to the till when victim recovered the wallet realised that some British currency was missing from it.

JANUARY 2024

1-LONDON UNDERGROUND, BOWES ROAD N11. On 12JAN24 at 2019 hours. Mobile phone was snatched from victim's hand while on bus stop. Suspects were on a bicycle.

2-BOWES ROAD N11. On 13JAN24 at 1015 hours. Two men committed an opportunist theft. The victim was approached by a male who affirmed to the victim that they got a ticket for parking in a restricted space. Another male came over to offer help to the victim, saying that it was easy to contest it via website. The victim ends up giving the suspects a bank card. Later, the victim realizes that the males have stolen their bank card.

3- ARNOS GROVE UNDERGROUND STATION N11. Friday 26JAN24 between 0700 and 0800 hours. A mobile phone was stolen from victim's pocket while victim was asleep.

4- ARNOS GROVE UNDERGROUND STATION N11. Saturday 27JAN24 1830. Mobile phone stolen from victim's bag, without victim notice it.

OTHER THEFT

MORTON WAY N14. On 26DEC23 at 0200. Theft of god statute that is kept outside the address by two males. The victim has followed them and reported the matter to police. The statute has been recovered intact.

THEFT CYCLE

December 2023

MORTON WAY N14. Between 2300 of 13DEC023 and 1640 hours of 14DEC23, the victim left his bike locked at the location as it had a flat tire. When the victim returned to the bike stand on 14/12/2023, at 1640 hours to find the bike had gone. It is not known exactly when the bike was taken as there is no CCTV or witnesses to the incident.
